The Forest Science and Technology Centre of Catalonia (CTFC), located in Solsona (Pre-Pyrenees, 120 km from Barcelona), Spain, is seeking to appoint a doctoral researcher to conduct applied research on:

- The functioning and dynamics of Mediterranean forests.
- Forest modelling, silvicultural guidelines and multifunctional forest management.

TERMS OF THE APPOINTMENT

- 1. This contract may start on July 2023. It is a fulltime permanent position.
- 2. The researcher will be based at CTFC in Solsona (NE Spain), as member of the Multifunctional Forest Management Program.
- 3. The candidate will be involved in different competitive and non-competitive projects (at European, national and regional scales).
- 4. Professional category: specialist researcher N2.
- 5. Salary: according to the candidate skills and expertise.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. To lead analyses of forest data and the production of scientific publications and technical reports.
- 2. To fit new models on tree growth and non-wood forest products (cork, mushrooms, etc) which will be implemented into the FORMES projection system (for multi-objective forest planning in Spain).
- 3. To contribute to monitoring permanent plots established in mixed and pure forests along environmental gradients in different Catalan mountain ranges.
- 4. To set up new experimental designs on adaptive management of Mediterranean forests.
- 5. To participate in the dissemination of results in scientific and technical meetings and knowledge transfer activities.
- 6. To lead the presentation of competitive and non-competitive projects and to contribute to the development and management of other ongoing projects within the Program.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Master's degree in forestry or forest engineering.
- 2. A completed PhD on Forest Sciences.
- 3. Capacity to design experiments, conduct applied research and manage projects on forest dynamics, modelling and silviculture.
- 4. Experience in managing R&D projects.
- 5. Proved experience in writing scientific manuscripts.



- 6. Demonstrable expertise in the use of advanced statistical techniques in R. Capacity to fit advanced models on forest growth and the production of non-wood forest products.
- 7. Experience in geographical information management techniques and data base management.
- 8. Fluent Spanish & English.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Experience on adaptive silviculture, close to nature forest management and non-wood forest products will be valued.
- 2. Willingness to join to the CTFC team as soon as possible.
- 3. Flexible person, responsible, problema-solver and organized person.
- 4. Teamwork capability.
- 5. Capacity in knowledge-transfer activities.
- 6. Catalan language.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

- 2. **Pre-selection:** verification of compliance with the minimum requirements of the offer.



- 3. Selection (from June 21th to June 30th 2023): assessment of the preselected candidates by scoring based on objective criteria and interview.
- 4. **Final decision:** in case of finding the suitable person, the election will be formally communicated to him/her, and the identification of the chosen person will be published on CTFC job openings section.
